

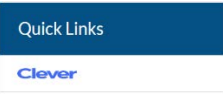


Helping Your Student with Clever on PCs and Chromebooks

1. Make sure you are using the most recent version of the Chrome browser.
2. Verify that the Clever Chrome Extension is installed. If it is installed, you will see a “C” in a blue box in the top right corner of the browser: 

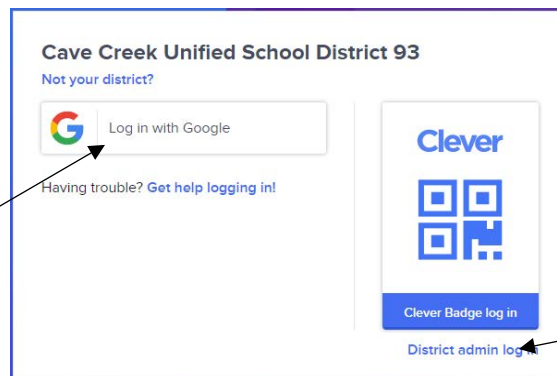
If the extension is not installed, go to the Chrome Web Store and search for “Clever”. Click on the Clever search result and follow the instructions to install the extension.

3. Call up the Clever Login page using one of the following methods:

	<p>From your student’s school website Home Page, scroll down to Popular Links and click on the Clever Student Login icon.</p>
	<p>From the CCUSD Home Page, scroll down to Quick Links and click on Clever.</p>

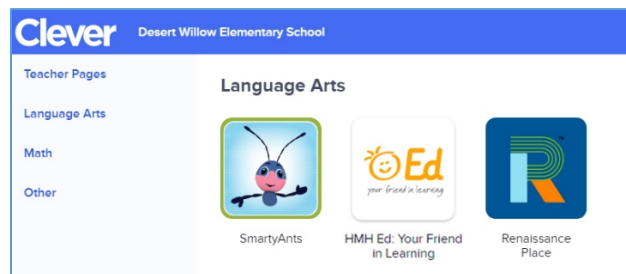
4. From the Clever Login Page, choose a the login method according to your child’s grade:

Click to have your student enter their Google username **([student #]@ccusd93.net)** and password.



Click to have your student display their Clever badge to the web camera until the green check mark appears.

Once your student is logged into Clever, they can click on the application icon they’d like to use:



If your student shares their device with another student, it is recommended that they log out of each application, and Clever itself (by clicking on their name on the top right), when they are done.

NOTE: The **ThinkCentral** icon is used to access **GoMath** and the **Ed: Your Friend in Learning** icon is used to access **Into Reading**. For more information, see the document *Logging into Into Reading and GoMath*.
