### Pre-Registration Directions for School Year 2017-2018

The course selections made by students at this time determine Cactus Shadows’ teacher needs for next year. Once classes are scheduled and teachers are hired, it is very difficult and sometimes impossible to make changes in courses. Students/parents will not be able to change course requests after February 24, 2017. Therefore, **it is extremely important that students confer with parents/guardians, teachers, and counselors at this time before finalizing course requests.**
